In order to promote outstanding young scientists, the Executive Board of the German Statistical Society invites applications for the following two

Young Scientists Prizes of the DStatG

for the year 2024.

1. DStatG-prize for the best Master's thesis
2. The DStatG prize for the best scientific publication produced as part of a scientific publication

The **DStatG prize for the best Master's thesis** is awarded to graduates who have completed their Master's degree with very good results in the past year and is endowed with 250 €. The proposal is made by a member of the DStatG (usually the first supervisor of the Master's thesis) and should include the Master's thesis, a brief justification and the two expert reports.

The **DStatG prize for the best scientific publication produced within the framework of a doctorate** is awarded to scientific publications produced within the framework of a doctorate that have been published or accepted for publication in the past year and is endowed with 250 €. The proposal is made by a member of the DStatG (as a rule, the first supervisor of the doctorate) and should include, in addition to the publication, a brief justification and, if applicable, a letter of confirmation from the scientific journal on the acceptance of the article. The junior researcher does not have to be a member of the DStatG. Self-proposals are not possible.
