In order to promote outstanding young scientists, the Executive Board of the German Statistical Society invites applications for the following two

## Young Scientists Prizes of the DStatG

for the year 2025.

1. DStatG-prize for the best Master's thesis
2. The DStatG prize for the best scientific publication produced as part of a scientific publication

The **DStatG prize for the best Master's thesis** is awarded to graduates who have completed their Master's degree with very good results in the past year and is endowed with 250 €. The proposal is made by a member of the DStatG (usually the first supervisor of the Master's thesis) and should include the Master's thesis, a brief justification and the two expert reports.

The DStatG prize for the best scientific publication produced within the framework of a doctorate is awarded to scientific publications produced within the framework of a doctorate that have been published or accepted for publication in the past year and is endowed with 250 €. The proposal is made by a member of the DStatG (as a rule, the first supervisor of the doctorate) and should include, in addition to the publication, a brief justification and, if applicable, a letter of confirmation from the scientific journal on the acceptance of the article. The junior researcher does not have to be a member of the DStatG. Self-proposals are not possible.
